

2019-2020 Heung To Middle School (TSW) Tuition Fees / Annual Fee Remission Scheme / Scholarship

A. Tuition Fees

| Grade | Monthly Tuition Fee | Total Instalments | Annual Tuition Fee* |

| S.1-S.3 | \$575 | 10 | \$5,750 |
| S.4-S.5 | \$736 | 10 | \$7,360 |
| S.6 | \$1060 / \$1050 | 7 | \$7,360 |

* Tuition fees already include extracurricular activity and air-conditioning fees (If the tuition fees are adjusted, the school will update them on school website).

B. Annual Fee Remission Scheme

1. Eligibility Criteria

- 1) Students from low-income families or have financial difficulties.
- 2) Non-recipients of the Full Fee Remission Scholarship in the current school year.
- 3) Applicants (including families currently in receipt of the Comprehensive Social Security Scheme) must provide the photocopies of family income supporting documents in the previous year (Salary Proof 1 Tax Demand Note 1 Pay Slips 1 Certificates of CSSA recipients 1 Eligibility Certificates (ECs) form Student Financial Assistance Agency or SFAA).

2. Application Procedures

- 1) At the beginning of each school year, the school issues a parental notice to all students, inviting eligible parents/guardians to apply. Parents/guardians should fill in the reply slip and submit it to the class teacher before the specified date;
- 2) Class teachers will distribute the application form to students who need to make the application;
- 3) Class teachers review the application forms and fill in the comments, and visit parents/guardians with special difficulties to understand their situation
- 4) Application forms will be collected and signed by the School General Office. The School Fee Subsidy Scheme Team will then assess the applications and announce the result later. A parental letter will be sent to inform parents/guardians

3. Method of Assessment

The assessment is based on the "Adjusted Family Income" mechanism from the SFAA, depending on the average family income of the student.

4. Level of Assistance

| Adjusted Family Income | Level of Assistance |
|------------------------|---------------------|
| Over \$77,810 | Ineligible |
| HK\$40,241- 77,810 | Half |
| HK\$0 – 40,240 | Full |

Remarks:

$$\text{AFI} = \frac{\text{Gross annual income of the family}}{\text{Number of family members} + 1 \text{ (single-parent family with 2-3 members +2)}}$$

5. The school reserves all the rights of assessment and discretion.

C. Scholarship

1. Academic and Conduct Scholarship
Those S1 to S5 students who have achieved the academic year results may be exempted from a half of the annual school fees
2. Parent-Teacher Association Scholarship
 - S6 students who receive the First, Second and Third Prizes for excellence in conduct and learning may get Parent-Teacher Association Scholarship.
 - S6 students who receive Level 5 or above in DSE may get Parent-Teacher Association Scholarship.
3. Other types of scholarships are granted to students with good performance in different areas every year.
