Special Notice on the Deferment of Class Resumption

On 21st March 2020, the Education Bureau announced class resumption in phases planned on 20th April is deferred. The final resumption date is subject to the announcement of the Education Bureau.

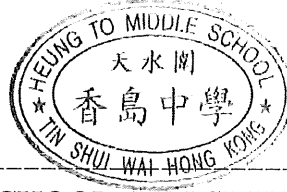
During the class suspension period, in order to ensure students' learning progress and the communication with students, teachers have used different measures for learning and teaching, including videos, shooting videos, uploading teaching materials, and conducting revision tests. Due to the prolonged suspension period and class resumption, teachers will continue to upload learning materials in Google Drive before 13:00pm every day, so that students can download the learning materials and complete them on time. At the same time, the school has also compiled a timetable (Refer to the attachment) for students to attend real-time classes from March 26 to April 8. Students need to download the software of ZOOM. Subject teachers will contact and inform students the arrangements of the classes. If schools cannot resume on April 20, students need to stay at home and follow the timetable to attend the real-time classes until schools resume. To ensure the progress and effectiveness of students' learning, starting from April 20, students must participate in real-time classes. The school will check and keep students' attendance of the classes. Students' scores in their homework and tests will be counted as part of their daily course work. The school asks that parents or guardians supervise your children to ensure learning continues and prepare for class resumption at home.

In addition, due to the deferment of DSE, S6 subject teachers will rearrange the revision strategies, including individual tutoring, group remedial and enhancement scheme, shooting short videos, and making good use of the electronic platform to prepare students for the exam in their best condition. Subject teachers will directly contact S6 students to inform them the specific revision arrangements.

The class teacher will keep in touch with parents and students during the class suspension period to grasp the health and learning progress of students. If students need counselling or parents have other concerns, please notify the class teacher to seek for appropriate and timely support.

The school is observing the latest developments of the Covid-19 and will inform parents or guardians of the updates via E-class or the school's website.
